

SOUTH FLORIDA FAIR GENERAL YOUTH JUDGING CONTEST RULES

Contests are open ONLY to youth who are members of 4-H Clubs or FFA Chapters.

**FFA Chapters and 4-H Clubs must call or e-mail Ms. Debbie Clements to preregister their team.
All entry forms will be collected the day of the contest.**

Each 4-H Club or FFA Chapter may enter as many teams as they wish. Teams consist of four members with the top three scores counted as the team total. Individuals may also be entered. The official judges will designate two classes to be used to rank individuals tied in total score.

During the contest, participants are not permitted to talk to another participant, advisor, coach, or spectator. The participants will not be allowed to use cell phones, walkie-talkies, or other communication devices during the contest. Any violation of this will result in disqualification of the individual from the contest. The top three teams and the top seven individuals will be recognized with awards.

Each contest may include up to eight classes. Classes will be determined by the Livestock Committee prior to the contest and will be made up of available animals at the Fair.
