YOUTH LIVESTOCK SHOW ETHICS AND ANIMAL CARE WORKSHOP

**PLEASE NOTE: Attendance will qualify for certification but
NOT for Achievement Points**

The Florida State Fair believes that every youth exhibitor should receive proper training and information for raising and showing a youth animal project. It is important that the exhibitors understand:

- The purpose of youth livestock projects
- The importance of ethics in youth livestock projects
- Proper animal handling and management
- The difference between animal welfare and animals rights
- Be prepared to be an ambassador for animal agriculture

The New Youth Livestock Show Ethics and Animal Care Workshop is designed to certify students to meet the mandatory certification requirements that will be in effect for the 2009 Florida State Fair. Certification is valid for a three (3) year period.

The requirements are as follows:

- All students that were entered at the 2006, 2007 or 2008 Florida State Fair must have completed the Ethics training to show an animal at the 2009 Florida State Fair.
- *Workshops will be offered around the state. Check our website for dates and times.*
- ***THE LAST WORKSHOP OFFERED FOR EXHIBITORS SHOWING AT THE 2008 FLORIDA STATE FAIR WILL BE JANUARY 19, 2009 AT RIVERVIEW HIGH SCHOOL***
- Youth that are exhibiting for the first time at the 2009 Florida State Fair will have a one (1) year grace period to complete the Ethics training.

This program has been endorsed by the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services and the University of Florida, Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences (IFAS).

From I-4 East - take exit 75B (Kirkman Rd) north; turn right on Colonial Drive.

From I-4 West - take exit 84 west.

From East-West Expressway (408) West - Take John Young Parkway exit North; turn left on Colonial Drive.

From East-West Expressway (408) East - Take Kirkman exit North; turn right on Colonial Drive.

From the northeast of PBC:

I-95 Belvedere Road Exit west to Military Trail, turn left into the right lane, turn right into Golf Road. (Hess Gas Station on east side, Dept of Motor Vehicles on the west side of Military Trail) Continue 1 block to end. Enter Cooperative Extension Complex.

From the southeast of PBC:

I-95 Southern Blvd Exit west to Military Trail, Turn right into the left lane, turn left (make a U-turn) into Golf Road. (Hess Gas Station on east side, Dept of Motor Vehicles on the west side of Military Trail) Continue 1 block to end. Enter Cooperative Extension Complex.

Coming from the northwest of PBC:

Turnpike to Okeechobee Blvd, east to Military Trail, right to Golf Road.

Coming from the southwest of PBC:

Turnpike to Southern Blvd, east to Military Trail, left to Golf Road.

From I-75 (Northbound) I-75, take Exit # 382, SR 121 (Williston Road) and go to the East. SR 121 will become 131 and then the road curves around to the left and becomes SR 24. Continue on SR 24, traveling North. Turn right onto NE 39th Avenue. Take the first left onto a service road. The Extension office is on the right next to Alachua County Fairgrounds.

If traveling Southbound on I-75, take Exit # 390, SR 222 (39th Avenue) and go to the East. Continue for about 10 miles. Cross Waldo Road. Take the first left onto a service road. The building is on the right next to the Alachua County Fairgrounds.
