All registered Dairy Cattle must be registered with their respective national breed association. Papers pending will not be accepted if registration papers are not available.

Entries: ENTRIES DUE DECEMBER 1st

1. Must use separate form for each breed and/or owner and separate entry form for Open and Youth.
2. Entry blanks must be filled out completely. You must enter group classes in advance, but it is not necessary to name the animals which make up your group or herd entries until after judging the individual classes. Entries in group and herd classes must have been exhibited previously in individual classes. Copies of registration and lease agreements must be attached to entry forms upon mailing.
3. No more than 2 entries per class.
4. Exhibitors must clean all areas before release forms will be issued by the Barn Superintendent.
5. There must be a minimum of five (5) animals before a Grand Champion will be declared.
6. No dogs in tent.

General Instructions

Section references are to the Internal Revenue Code unless otherwise noted.

Purpose of Form

A person who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) to report, for example, income paid to you, real estate transactions, mortgage interest you paid, acquisition or abandonment of secured property, cancellation of debt, or contributions you made to an IRA.

Rules & Regulations

1. Exhibitors cannot be under the age of 8 or over the age of 19 as of September 1, 2009. Exhibitors must, also, be attending school or be enrolled in a valid home school program. Exhibitors who have graduated from high school or obtained their high school G.E.D. are not eligible.
3. **ENTRIES DUE: DECEMBER 1st.** All entries must be on an official livestock form. FORMS ARE MARKED FOR OPEN AND YOUTH
4. All cattle over 6 months old or with horns over 2" in length must have horns removed.
5. All grade animals must be worthy of the breed they represent, and the Committee reserves the right to refuse entry of animals that do not meet these standards.
6. Youth exhibitors will be permitted to exhibit one animal per class, plus any bred by exhibitor.
7. The exhibitor is to see that his animal is fed, cleaned, etc., for the duration of the Fair. If not, there will be a \$15.00 per head/per day charge.
8. It is strongly recommended that all animals be immunized for blackleg, malignant edema, shipping fever, the IBR Complex and the BVD Complex 30 days prior to the Fair date.
9. All animals must have suitable halter and DOUBLE tie before they will be admitted to the show barn and must be halter broken to be exhibited by owner.
10. All animals must have been transferred to the owner and exhibitor at least sixty (60) days prior to the show.
11. Neither the local interest participating in the sponsorship of the show, nor any of the personnel shall be responsible for any accidents or errors that may occur. However, every effort will be made to provide for the safety and comfort of the guests and their cattle.
12. Tampering with any animals entered, such as injecting with a foreign substance, etc. is prohibited. The use of tranquilizers on show animals after arrival at the Fair will be construed as a form of tampering.
13. **Dairy cattle must be in the barn between 10:00 a.m. and 12 Noon on Thursday, January 28, 2010. Check-in will be between 1-4 p.m.**
14. All dairy cattle will arrive at the designated time, including lactating animals, as milking facilities will be furnished by the Fair. Only female animals will be shown in the Dairy Shows.
15. Exhibitors MUST clean all areas before release forms will be signed by Barn Superintendent.

Eligibility All registered dairy cattle must be registered with their respective National Breed Association. Papers pending will not be accepted if registration papers are not available by show date.

Rules & Regulations:

1. Each participant must furnish one dairy heifer to be used. While there are no age requirements on the animal, we suggest that the animal be at least a junior yearling.
2. The animal must be clean and dry upon entering the ring for the contest.
3. Since nose tongs will not be allowed in the contest, we require all animals to be clipped from, including, the head and upper half of the neck before entering the ring for the contest. The remaining part of the animal MUST be unclipped. Hooves should be trimmed as well.
4. While grooming chutes are not required, their use is encouraged. Grooming chutes will not be supplied by the Fair.
5. Each individual will have **1 1/2** hours to complete the clipping of their animal.
6. Any help from outside to an individual will result in an immediate disqualification.
7. Any questions concerning rules and regulations should be directed to the show superintendent. All decisions will be made by the superintendent and his committee.
8. Anyone not cooperating with the superintendent or his committee will be disqualified and forfeit any prize money or award.

Scoring:

A team of 2-3 judges will evaluate each entrant and the animal. Each animal will be inspected before entering the ring. Observation during the contest and final evaluation of the groomed animal will be accounted for as a part of selecting the winning participant.

Scorecard:

- (20 PTS) 1. **Condition and thriftiness:** Showing normal growth, being neither too fat nor too thin.
- (30 PTS) 2. **Grooming:** Hair properly groomed and clean. The hide soft and pliable. Hair dressing should not be used in excess. Hooves trimmed and shaped to enable the animal to walk and stand naturally.
- (30 PTS) 3. **Clipping:** The hair is properly clipped to show the animal to the best advantage. The hair is well blended and areas are free of clip marks. The animal has an overall smooth appearance.
- (20 PTS) 4. **Cleanliness:** Hair and switch are clean and free from stains. Hide and ears are free of dirt, legs and feet are clean.

I am not subject to backup withholding because: (a) I am exempt from backup withholding, or (b) I have not been notified by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) that I am subject to backup withholding as a result of a failure to report all interest or dividends, or (c) the IRS has notified me that I am no longer subject to backup withholding, and
3. I am a U.S. citizen or other U.S. person (defined below).

Certification instructions. You must cross out item 2 above if you have been notified by the IRS that you are currently subject to backup withholding because you have failed to report all interest and dividends on your tax return. For real estate transactions, item 2 does not apply. For mortgage interest paid, acquisition or abandonment of secured property, cancellation of debt, contributions to an individual retirement arrangement (IRA), and generally, payments other than interest and dividends, you are not required to sign the Certification, but you must provide your correct TIN. General Instructions

Section references are to the Internal Revenue Code unless otherwise noted.

Purpose of Form

A person who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) to report, for example, income paid to you, real estate transactions, mortgage interest you paid, acquisition or abandonment of secured property, cancellation of debt, or contributions you made to an IRA.

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN to the person requesting it (the requester) and, when applicable, to:

1. Certify that the TIN you are giving is correct (or you are waiting for a number to be issued),
2. Certify that you are not subject to backup withholding, or
3. Claim exemption from backup withholding if you are a U.S. exempt payee. If applicable, you are also certifying that as a U.S. person, your allocable share of any partnership income from a U.S. trade or business is not subject to the withholding tax on foreign partners' share of effectively connected income.

Note. If a requester gives you a form other than Form W-9 to request your TIN, you must use the requester's form if it is substantially similar to this Form W-9.

Definition of a U.S. person. For federal tax purposes, you are considered a U.S. person if you are:

- An individual who is a U.S. citizen or U.S. resident alien,
- A partnership, corporation, company, or association created or organized in the United States or under the laws of the United States,
- An estate (other than a foreign estate), or
- A domestic trust (as defined in Regulations section 301.7701-7).

Special rules for partnerships. Partnerships that conduct a trade or business in the United States are generally required to pay a withholding tax on any foreign partners' share of income from such business. Further, in certain cases where a Form W-9 has not been received, a partnership is required to presume that a partner is a foreign person, and pay the withholding tax. Therefore, if you are a U.S. person that is a partner in a partnership conducting a trade or business in the United States, provide Form W-9 to the partnership to establish your U.S. status and avoid withholding on your share of partnership income.

The person who gives Form W-9 to the partnership for purposes of establishing its U.S. status and avoiding withholding on its allocable share of net income from the partnership conducting a trade or business in the United States is in the following cases:

- The U.S. owner of a disregarded entity and not the entity,
